He gave me land and water. He made the fresh air all around me. He decorated me with beautiful flowers and trees.





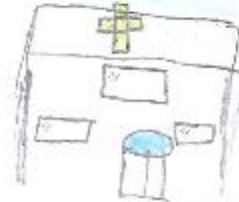
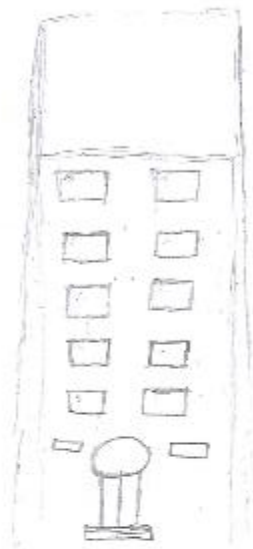
He filled the water with fishes and other weird and wonderful creatures. He filled the land with majestic lions, grizzly bears, ferocious tigers and many more.....

You needed places to work so you built towers, skyscrapers....you built schools, hospitals, police stations and much much more.....

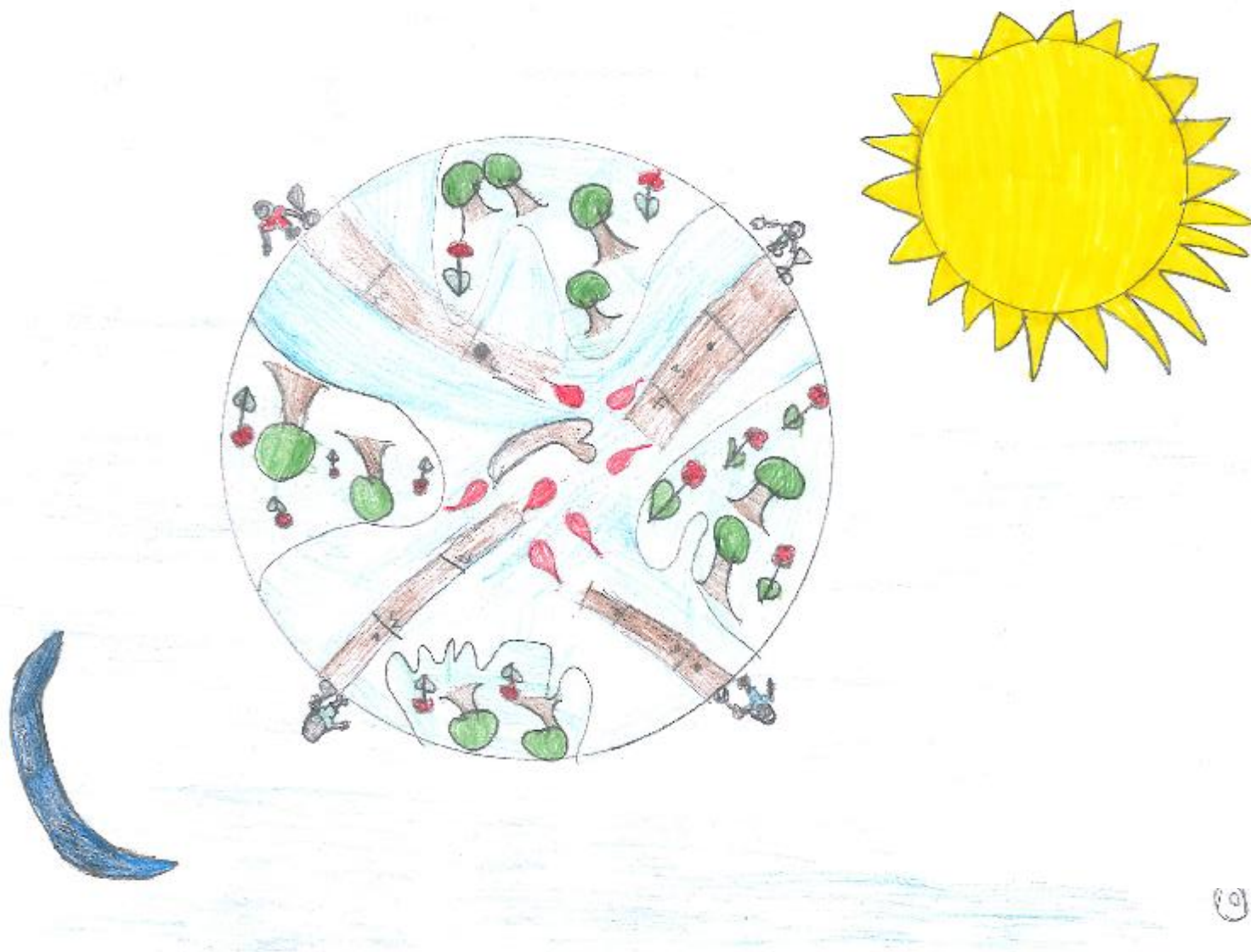


But the houses and buildings need heating,
