Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) received

£3960

Summary of PPG spending 2017/18

In our school we used this funding to:

- Provide additional hours for a teaching assistant to deliver bespoke interventions. These include Toe by Toe, Word Wasp and FFT Wave 3.
- Provide TA hours to deliver ongoing Speech and Language support activities.

Summary of spending:

- £3460—towards additional teaching assistant hours to deliver bespoke interventions to target pupils.
- £1000— to fund school trips, after school clubs and residential visits.

Impact of spending:

- The pupils receiving the intervention programmes have made significant progress. This support enabled them to pass the Y1 phonics screening test.
- Speech and language support is ongoing but significant progress is being made.
- Participation in after school sports clubs has increased fitness for target pupils evidenced by fitness testing at the beginning and the end of the academic year.

Summary of PPG proposed spending 2018/19

- Provide TA hours to deliver a bespoke intervention to one pupil and to carry out Word Wasp, Toe-by-Toe and Precision Teaching interventions to a further three pupils.
- The impact of this additional 1:1 and/or small group support will be measured by pupils' reading ages being in line or above chronological age and the phonics screening test pass %.
