Summary of PPG spending 2018/19

In our school we used this funding to:

- Provide additional hours for a teaching assistant to deliver bespoke interventions. These include Toe by Toe, Word Wasp, Talking Partners and FFT Wave 3.

Summary of spending 2018/19:

- £3960—towards additional teaching assistant hours to deliver bespoke interventions to target pupils.

Impact of spending:

- The pupils receiving the intervention programmes have made significant progress. This support enabled them reach expected levels at the end of year 2. They were previously emerging at the end of EYFS. Reading and maths ages are also in line with chronological age.

Summary of PPG proposed spending 2019/20

- Provide TA hours to deliver a bespoke intervention to one pupil and to carry out Word Wasp, Toe-by-Toe and Precision Teaching interventions to a further two pupils.
- The impact of this additional 1:1 and/or small group support will be measured by pupils' reading ages being in line or above chronological age and the phonics screening test pass %.
