Summary of PPG spending 2019/20

In our school we used this funding to:

- Provide additional hours for a teaching assistant to deliver bespoke interventions. These include Toe by Toe, Word Wasp, Talking Partners and Turnabout. It also funded an annual subscription to Nessy.

Summary of spending 2019/20:

- £1320—towards additional teaching assistant hours to deliver bespoke interventions to target pupils.

Impact of spending:

- Due to the coronavirus lockdown, the impact of the spending can only be recorded up to March 2020. Pupils receiving intervention made an increase of 3 months and 6 months in reading ages. They also both moved up by a book band in the reading scheme. Phonics screening tests did not happen, nor did KS1 SATs so comparative data cannot be recorded.

Summary of PPG proposed spending 2020/21

- Provide TA hours to deliver a bespoke intervention to one pupil and to carry out Word Wasp, Toe-by-Toe and Precision Teaching interventions to a further three pupils.
- The impact of this additional 1:1 and/or small group support will be measured by pupils' reading ages being in line or above chronological age and the phonics screening test pass %.
- Provide pupils with Relax Kids sessions on a weekly basis to support the return to school, as part of the recovery curriculum.
