Dear Parent/Carers,

Welcome back to the second half of the autumn term. We are so proud of how happy the children are to be back, and how well they have settled back into school life! School will remain open during the 2nd national lockdown.

Parents are requested to wear face coverings on site, keep at a socially acceptable distance from each other and leave school quickly at pick up and drop off times. We will continue to follow strict hygiene measures in school.

What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, they must not come to school and should remain at home for at least 10 days from the date when their symptoms appeared. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for testing.

Symptoms

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

If you are concerned about your child's symptoms, or they are worsening, you can seek advice from NHS 111 at https://111.nhs.uk/ or by phoning 111.

If your child does test positive for COVID 19 would you please advise school by telephone or email straightaway.

How to stop COVID-19 spreading

There are things you can do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with COVID-19 Do

- wash your hands with soap and water often do this for at least 20 seconds
- use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- wash your hands as soon as you get home
- cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- put used tissues in the bin immediately and wash your hands afterwards


