### A SPECIAL WELCOME TO OUR NEW STARTERS



### ON THE FIRST DAY...

As you may be aware the start to school will be slightly different this year. The children will be dropped off in the following way:

Nursery and Reception - 8.45 - 8.55 a.m. drop off and 3.15 p.m. pick up using the EYFS classroom door.

Year 1 and 2 - 8.45-8.55 a.m. drop off and 3.15 p.m. pick up using the hall door.

**Year 3 and 4** - 8.45-8.55 a.m. drop off and 3.15 p.m. pick up using the wooden gate by the kitchen. This is to the right of the main school entrance.
