Ghana	A country in West Africa.
plains	Large areas of land that are mostly flat.
Kente cloth	A special weaved cloth from Ghana
Antarctica	Is the very cold and icy area around the South Pole.
Melting	When something changes from a solid to a liquid.
Freezing	When liquid becomes a solid.
