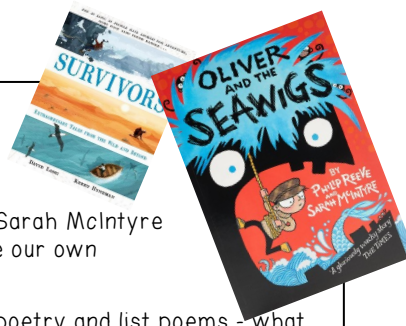

## English



This term will be:

Exploring *Oliver and the Seawigs* by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre and *Survivors* by David Long and using these to inspire our own adventure stories.

Learning all about poetry and in particular free verse poetry and list poems - what are they, how do we read them and what makes them unique?

We will be writing our own persuasive letters based on whether tourism is a positive or a negative thing in the mountain environments.

Taking part in individual reading, shared reading as a class and our whole-class guided reading sessions to explore books in more detail and get our teeth stuck into some juicy texts!

Continuing to develop and refine our editing and improving skills as part of the writing process. Continuing to learn about the Year 3/4 Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation curriculum!

## Mathematics



- ◇ We will be continuing to explore multiplication and division by multiplying and dividing using written methods and solving correspondence problems.
- ◇ Exploring lengths (m, cm and mm), what kilometres are, area, making shapes, perimeter and solving problems with these.
- ◇ Exploring fractions and decimals, including what tenths and hundredths are!

## History



This term we will be exploring the lives and legacy of The Tudors - we will be looking closely at the Tudors within the local area!

- ◇ Place the Tudors on a timeline and explore the Tudor family tree.
- ◇ Think about what life was like for children in Tudor times, investigating the differences between rich and poor lifestyles.
- ◇ Explore and visit Tutbury Castle and why it was such a significant place during the Tudor period in England - and it is just a 10 minute drive from us!
- ◇ Who were the Tudor monarchs and what was their impact on our country and our local area? Henry VIII and Elizabeth I.
- ◇ All of this will be explored under the lens of our local area and how the Tudors influenced where we live!

## Geography



On our Travels - we will be exploring Mighty Mountains! We will be discovering what mountains are, where the mountain ranges are in the world, famous mountains and comparing a mountain environment here in the UK to one elsewhere in the world.
