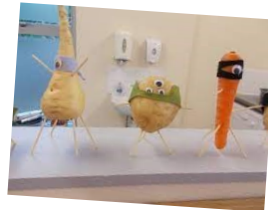

Literacy

Reception will be reading:

- Lots of non-fiction books about people who help us (firefighters, police, doctors, vets).
 - The Colour Monster
 - Burglar Bill
 - Supertato
- Have daily shared reading sessions
- Take part in weekly 'Rhyme Time'



They will also...

- Have daily phonics (**Little Wandle**)
- Practise pre-writing skills and mark-making
- Name writing

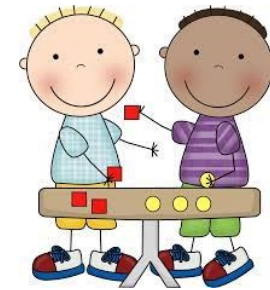


All of the above will be taught through exciting and engaging 'wow' moments and stimulus to allow children the opportunity to begin to write for purpose.

Mathematics

Reception children will:

- Be baselined on counting skills and number knowledge
- Learn how to represent numbers using a range of mathematical equipment
- Begin to compare numbers using the language of more and fewer.
- Learn and explore the composition of number (the idea that all numbers are made up of smaller numbers).



- Learn about 2d shapes, their properties and where shapes can be seen in around them. .
