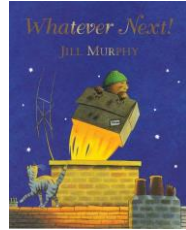


Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Neil Armstrong	the first man to step on the moon
Tim Peake	a famous British astronaut who worked on the International Space Station
astronaut	a person who is trained to travel into space in a spacecraft
past	any time before now
present	now
Lunar module	a small craft used for travelling between the moon's surface and an orbiting spacecraft
moonscape	the rocky and barren landscape of the moon
Apollo 11	the American spaceflight that first landed humans on the moon
Sea of Tranquility	a dark spot on the Northern Hemisphere of the moon
International Space Station	a large spacecraft in orbit around the Earth. It is a large science laboratory
scientist	a person who conducts scientific research or investigation
