

## English

This term we will be reading 'Man on the Moon: A day in the life of Bob' by Simon Bertram'.

We will cover the following in our writing:

- Nouns
- Verbs
- Simple sentences
- Adjectives
- Compound sentences
- Pronouns
- Proper nouns



## History

This term we will be investigating and comparing the lives of significant explorers through our key question: 'What have we learned from the past?'

- What exploring means, what an explorer is and what makes someone significant.
- The lives and achievements of Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake and comparing them.
- Learning how space technology has developed over time.



## Geography

We will explore different climates and places through the key question: 'What on Earth?'

- Focusing on the Arctic, Antarctica and the Equator.
- Looking at seasons and weather patterns.



## Mathematics

This term, Year 1 children will be deepening knowledge and skills in place value within 10, addition and subtraction within 10 and shape.

This term, Year 2 children will also be depending knowledge and skills in place value within 100, addition and subtraction within 100 and shape.

## Science

This term we will be exploring seasons, animals and materials:

- We will observe changes across the 4 seasons and describe weather associated with the seasons.
- We will be discovering the basic parts of the human body and identifying the 5 senses.
- We will distinguish differences between everyday materials and describe, compare and group their physical properties.



## R.E.

Our focus for the first half term is on asking the question: 'What are festivals and why do we have them?'. We will look at a range of religious festivals and how these are celebrated by different religions.

We will also be finding out 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?' in Autumn 2. We will explore the Nativity story and the importance of Jesus' birth to Christians.



## D.T.

We will be creating our own fabric Christmas decorations, choosing and manipulating fabrics to create different effects, joining fabrics and evaluating.



### RSE and PSHE

We will be answering the question 'What makes a good friend?' by looking at friendships, feeling lonely and managing arguments.

We will also be answering the question 'What is bullying?' by looking at behaviour, bullying, words and actions and respect for others.



### Art and Design



In art this term, we will be exploring colour through revolutionary artists:

- Primary, secondary, neutral, warm and cool colours.
- Colour mixing, shading and tinting.
- Piet Mondrian, Mark Rothko, Paul Klee, Jackson Pollock, Robert and Sonia Delaunay, and Wassily Kandinsky.
