# Block Printing and Illustrations:

## William Morris!

pattern	A repeated or regular design.
block printing	Printing patterns using pieces (blocks) of wood that have been carved.
Arts and Crafts Movement	The Arts and Crafts movement, which William Morris founded, wanted a return to skilled workmanship and high quality goods instead of machine-made items.
still life	A work of art that shows objects from the natural or man-made world.
observation	Closely watching something.



### What do I already know?

#### EYs and KS1 - Art and Design:

Primary and secondary colours, printing (stamps), repeated patterns, sketching (portraits).

### Links to the National Curriculum:

Pupils should be taught to develop their techniques, including their control and their use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of art, craft and design.

Pupils should be taught:

- ◆ to create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas
- ◆ to improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay]
- ◆ about great artists, architects and designers in history.
