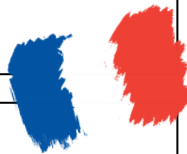

English

We will learn about and write our own:

- Story (narrative) problem
- Story (narrative) resolution

We will be using the following texts as our inspiration:

- The Incredible Book Eating Boy by Oliver Jeffers
- The Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry

We be learning about and learning to use:

- Complex sentences with a wider range of conjunctions
- Expanded noun phrases with prepositional phrases



History

In History, we will think about why we remember people and in Class 3, we will focus on Lord Shaftesbury and Dr. Barnardo in the Victorian era. They had a massive impact on the lives of working British children at this time and we will learn about changes they made to help.

We will learn about jobs that working children did at the time and what their lives would have been like, before these men help to change things.

We will explore workhouses and working conditions for people in them.

Finally, we will look at the lasting legacy of these men, such as the Barnardo's charity and laws about working conditions that still exist today.

Mathematics

- We will be continuing to explore multiplication and division by multiplying and dividing using written methods and solving correspondence problems.
- Exploring lengths (m, cm and mm), what kilometres are, area, making shapes, perimeter and solving problems with these.
- Exploring fractions and decimals, including what tenths and hundredths are!



Religious Education

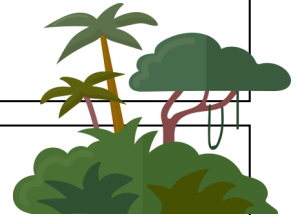
Our two big questions for the Spring Term are...

Geography

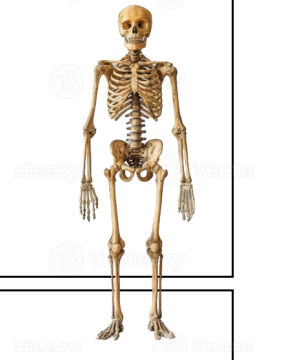
