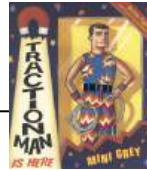


English

This term we will be reading 'Traction Man' by Mini Grey and 'Handa's Surprise' by Eileen Browne.

We will cover the following in our writing:

- Coordinating conjunctions
- Commas



History

This term we will be investigating and comparing the lives of significant people through our key question: 'Why do we remember people?'

- Learning about the lives of Louis Braille, Rosa Parks and Florence Nightingale
- The impact of their achievements and how we live our lives now, thanks to them



Mathematics

This term, Year 1 children will be deepening knowledge and skills in place value within 20, addition and subtraction within 20, place value within 50, length and height, and mass and volume.

This term, Year 2 children will also be deepening knowledge and skills in money, multiplication and division, length and height, and mass, capacity and temperature.

Geography

We will explore different climates and places through the key question: 'Where on Earth?'

- Learning about Africa in comparison to the United Kingdom
- Comparing Kenya and Bumala'B to England and Draycott
- Researching national parks and wildlife, including the 'big 5'
- Learning about life in the Maasai Mara



R.E.

Our focus for the first half term is on answering the question: 'What does it mean to be a Jew?'. We will look at a Synagogue, the ten statements, the Torah, Sabbath and Hanukkah.

We will also be finding out 'Why does Easter matter to Christians?' in Spring 2. We will explore Shrove Tuesday, Ash Wednesday, Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday and how Christians celebrate Easter.



Science

This term we will be exploring everyday materials and their uses:

- Investigating the suitability of different materials for specific purposes
- Identifying and comparing the suitability of everyday materials
- Finding out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching



RSE and PSHE

We will be answering the question 'What helps us to stay healthy?' by looking at being healthy, hygiene, medicines and people who help keep us healthy.

We will also be answering the question 'What can we do with money?' by looking at money, making choices and needs and wants.
