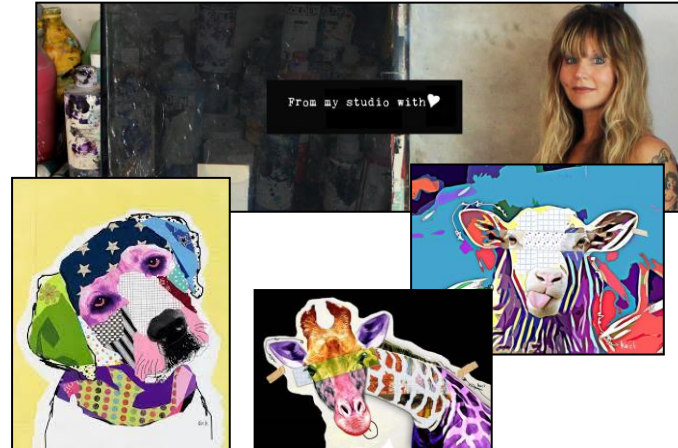
collage	A piece of art made by sticking different materials (such as paper, fabric or photographs) onto a surface.
mixed media	Artwork that uses more than one material or technique in the same piece.
sketch	A quick drawing used to practise ideas.
texture	The way something feels or looks like it feels, for example rough, smooth or bumpy.
material	The substance something is made from, such as paper, fabric, wood or plastic.
