English

We will learn about and write our own:

- Story (narrative) opening
- Story (narrative) build-up

We will be using the following texts as our inspiration:

- Our Tower by Joseph Coelho
- Cinderella of the Nile by Beverley Naidoo

We be learning about and learning to use:

- To write complex sentences using subordinating conjunctions in the middle or at the beginning of the sentence.
- To use fronted adverbials (where, when, how) with a comma to mark the boundary.



Mathematics

- ◇ We will begin by exploring place value of 3-digit numbers up to 1000 (Y3) and up to 10,000 (Y4)
- ◇ We will then develop our number knowledge by applying it during our addition and subtraction unit.
- ◇ The Y4s will also explore some shape by completing their area unit.
- ◇ We will all finish of the term beginning to look at multiplication and division.
- ◇ All this will be following White Rose Maths, supplemented with other high-quality resources to develop our reasoning and mastery skills!

Geography

This half term, we will consider the key question 'Who am I and where am I from?'. As part of this, we will use maps and grid references to plan routes and draw simple maps. We will use atlases to identify countries and continents. We will learn about the countries that make up the UK and its human and physical features. We will consider how countries are similar and different.



History

In the second half-term, we will be exploring what it was like in Ancient Egypt. We will look at where this period fits on a timeline and we will explore what made this civilisation so great through a range of historical sources. What legacy did Ancient Egypt leave behind?

Science

In the first half term our unit is Animals including humans with the focus on teeth and digestion.

The children will explore how the different parts of our body work in order to aid the digestion of our food.

In the second part of the term our unit is States of Matter.

The children will learn about the properties of the three states of matter, solid, liquid and gas. They will briefly also explore the water cycle.



Design and Technology
